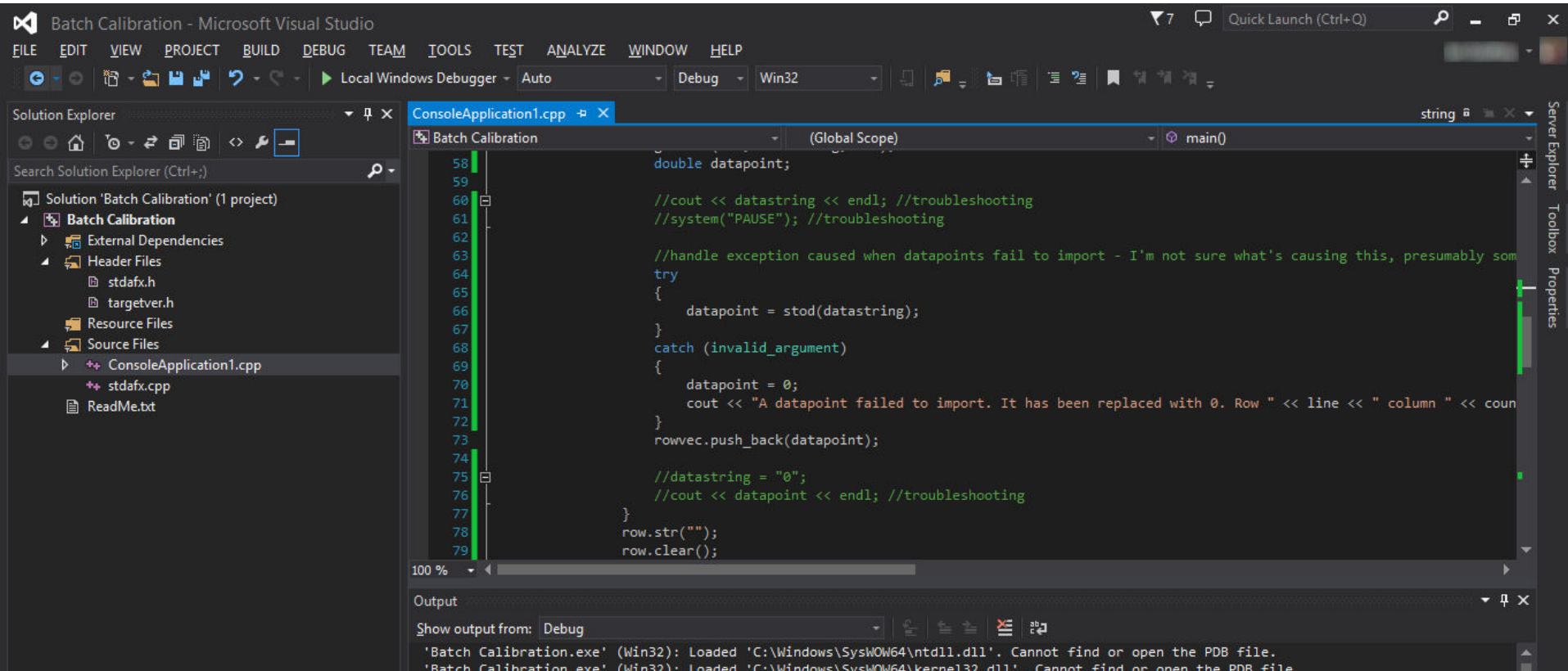

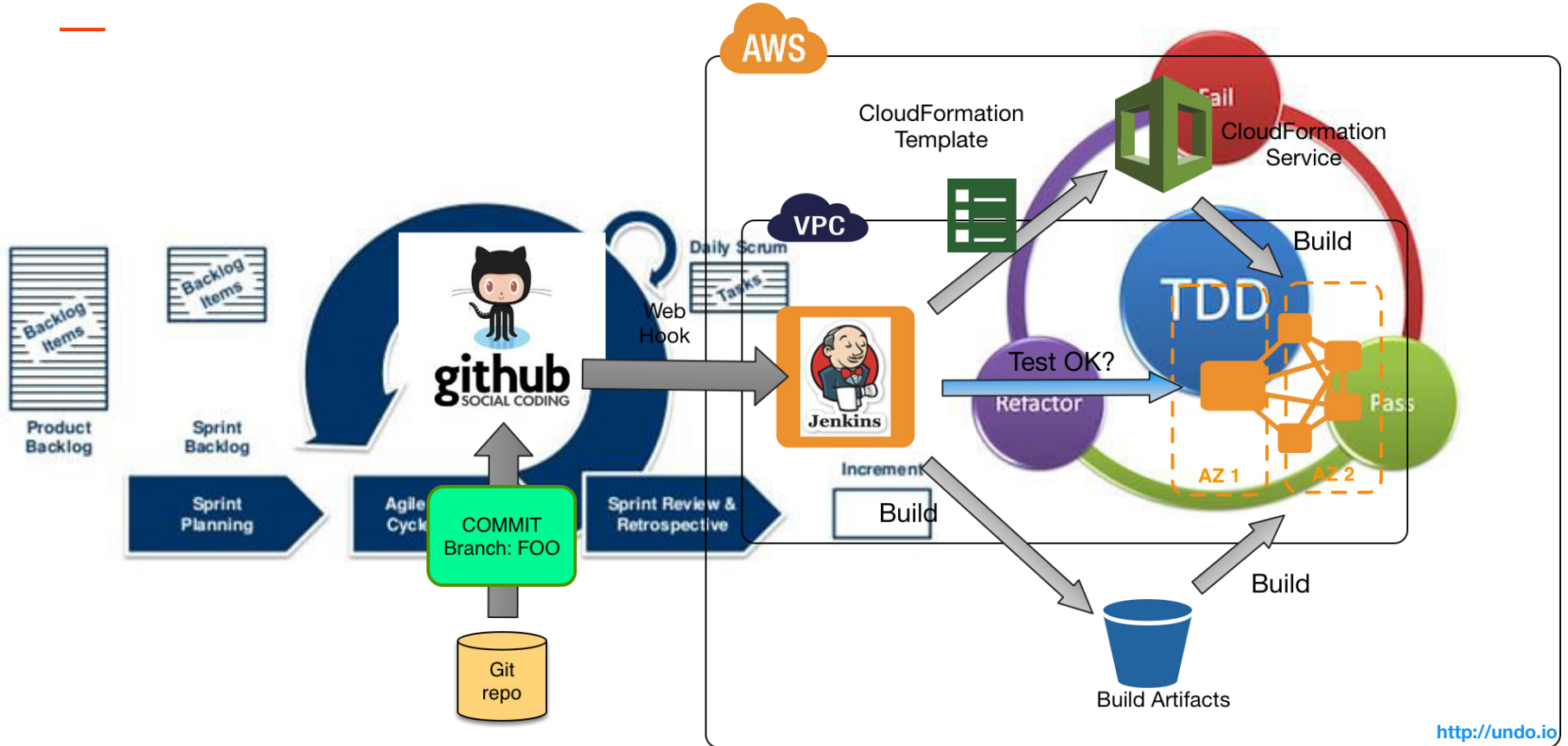
Realising the full potential

Search space thousands of lines

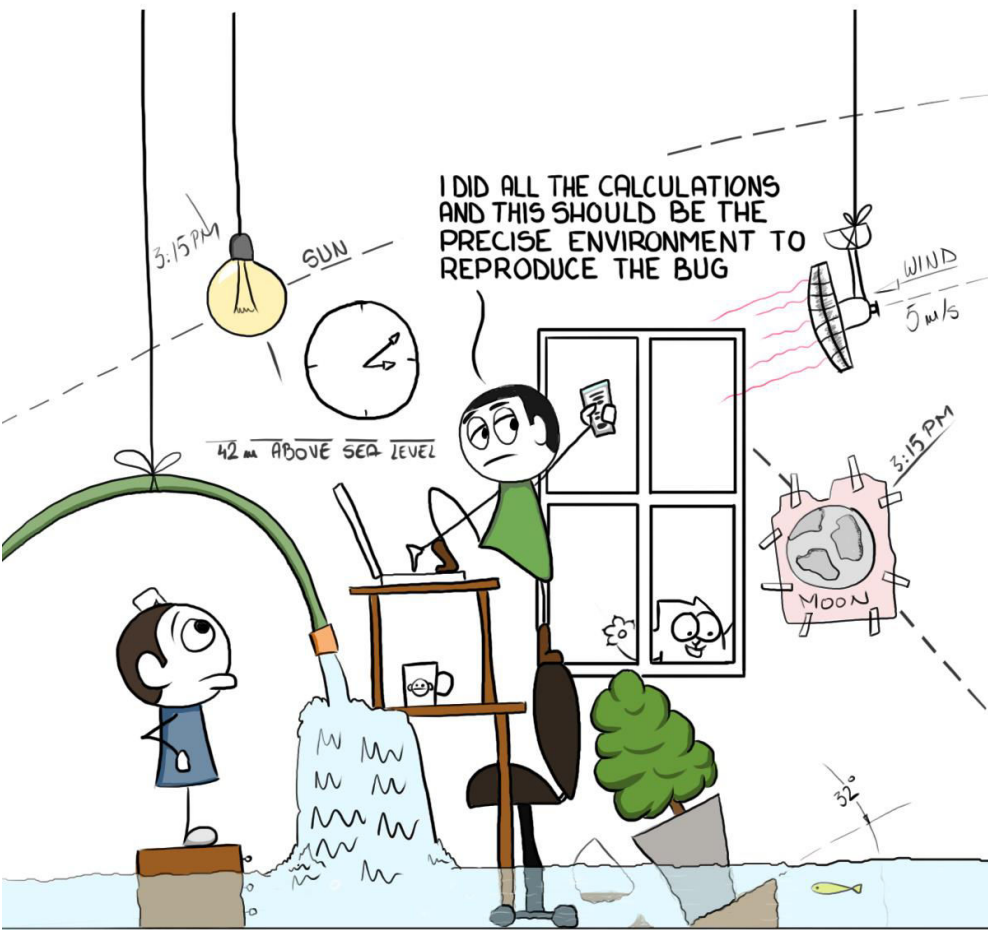
## **Exposing a dormant issue**
